SBCAG STAFF REPORT

SUBJECT: Highway 101: Contract Amendment No. 3 with MNS

MEETING DATE: June 20, 2019

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement with MNS Engineers for Highway 101 for utility and railroad coordination to extend the period of performance for an additional three years through June 30, 2023, and to increase the amount by \$125,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$375,000.

DISCUSSION:

Staff is recommending approval by the SBCAG board of amendment no. 3 to the agreement with MNS Engineers (MNS), who has been retained to provide corridor support services in the areas of utility coordination and railroad coordination to support the advancement of the Highway 101: Carpinteria to Santa Barbara Project. MNS has also provided surveying support for field staking for miscellaneous field efforts and surveying for local projects. This amendment recommends that the SBCAG extend the period of performance on the MNS contract to June 30, 2023, and provide additional budget authority of \$125,000.

SBCAG and Caltrans, through an MOU and cooperative agreements have agreed to share corridor-wide services for the Highway 101: Carpinteria to Santa Barbara project. The utility coordination and railroad coordination are two of those key areas being provided by SBCAG through MNS. MNS, as a local consultant, has also been able to nimbly provide services such as conceptual mapping and engineering surveys to expedite work done by the County of Santa Barbara for some of the local coastal access projects.

Approval of Amendment No. 3 to the agreement with MNS will continue the following services.

- Utility Coordination
 - Utility Conflict Notifications
 - Utility Agreements
 - Corridor Wide Utility Coordination
 - Review of Estimates
- Railroad Coordination
 - Corridor Wide Railroad Coordination
 - Review of Design/Strategies with Contractor
 - Coordinate Railroad Right of Way
- Local Project Survey Support for Coastal Access Projects
