

## SBCAG STAFF REPORT

**SUBJECT:** Highway 101: Montecito (4D) and Santa Barbara (4E)

**RECOMMENDATION:**  
Approve and authorize the Chair to execute Amendment No. 4 to the Cooperative Agreement (05-0347) with Caltrans for the pre-construction phases of the Highway 101: Carpinteria to Santa Barbara Project – Segments 4D and 4E. The total Agreement amount is increased by \$68,000 to be revised to \$26,747,000, including local funds which remain unchanged in the amount of \$19,849,000 from Measure A. The Board must approve additional contributions of Measure A funds for this Project, if required.

**DISCUSSION:**  
SBCAG and Caltrans continue to work to meet project delivery goals for the remaining two segments of the Highway 101 project through Montecito and Santa Barbara. SBCAG is the implementing agency for these two segments and has retained the services of the consultant team lead by Mark Thomas and Company, as well as other subconsultants providing support services. Caltrans is providing oversight of the design, providing support services such as surveying and geotechnical, and is the contracting lead for the Construction Manager General Contractor (CMGC) delivery method. In February 2019, SBCAG and Caltrans entered into a cooperative agreement (05-0347) for the PS&E and ROW phases covering Segments 4D Montecito and Segment 4E Santa Barbara. Staff is recommending approval of Amendment No. 4 to cooperative agreement 05-0347 to program additional \$68,000 in SB1 Local Partnership Program (LPP) formula funds to this project to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates (PS&E) phase to continue to support the effort to get these two segments ready for construction. Additional effort has been required for the (PS&E) phase based on segregating the two remaining segments in pre-construction, Montecito (4D) and Santa Barbara (4E), into sub-segment packages for improved funding flexibility through SB1 programs. SBCAG’s local contribution under this agreement remains unchanged.
